First Steps in Music is a developmentally appropriate and carefully researched early childhood music program. The class is appropriate for children from birth to age 5. Both children and caregivers will be active participants, learning many finger plays, bounces, tickles, circle songs, echo songs and more to be sung at home again and again. The curriculum, developed by Hartt professor and children's music pedagogue John Feierabend, is rich in folk songs from a variety of cultures. The goal of the class is to help children begin their journey toward becoming "tuneful, beatful, and artful" human beings.
